### M4 Junctions 8/9 to 10 Closures: Resurfacing near Shurlock Row



#### What's happening?

I am writing to advise that Kier Highways, on behalf of Highways England, are planning on resurfacing sections of the M4 east and westbound carriageways near Shurlock Row, to improve people's journeys and ensure the network remains in a safe and serviceable condition.

Highways England undertakes the majority of resurfacing works on the Strategic Road Network using a lower noise material. This material is thinner than conventional Hot Rolled Asphalt and has qualities which reduces noise levels.

#### When?

Work to the westbound carriageway is currently scheduled to start on Thursday 27 April 2017\* and is expected to take 10 nights to complete (Monday to Friday only).

Dates for work to the eastbound carriageway are yet to be confirmed, but are likely to be mid to late May 2017.

#### Traffic Management

In order to carry out the resurfacing work as efficiently and safely as possible, the M4 westbound carriageway from junctions 8/9 to 10 will be fully closed overnight between 10pm to 6am, when traffic flows are at their lowest.


A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A404(M), A4 and A329(M).


**Confirmed dates for the closures will be displayed in advance on signs along the M4.**
