176/2015. ASSISTANT CLERK RECRUITMENT

Proposal to appoint Anita Isabelle as the Assistant Clerk based on 21 hours per week, which includes provision of 1 hour per week for planning meetings. Starting salary LC18 £17,714 pro rata, (£9.21 per hour) rising to LC19 £18,360 pro rata (£9.55 per hour) after 6 months and subject to a satisfactory performance review.

Decision: Proposed Cllr Graham, seconded Cllr Yates, vote unanimous.

177/2015. PARISH CLERK RECRUITMENT

Proposal to appoint Susan Cook as the Parish Clerk based on 37.5 hours per week, which includes provision of .5 hours per week for evening meetings. Starting salary LC31 £27,123 (£14.10 per hour) rising to LC32 £27,924 (£14.51 per hour) after 6 months and subject to a satisfactory performance review.
