Introduction and welcome by Cllr Chris Graham

Cllr Graham welcomed everyone to the 121st Annual Electors Meeting and outlined the items on the agenda.

Presentation by Patrick Griffin of CPRE

Cllr Graham introduced Patrick Griffin who gave a presentation of the view of the CPRE on the 'Broken Borough Local Plan', which was followed by a Q&A session.

Presentation by Richard Davenport and John Morgan from Maidenhead Waterways

Cllr Graham introduced Richard Davenport and John Morgan who gave a presentation on 'Restoring the Cut between the Thames and Maidenhead' which was followed by a Q&A session.

Presentation by Maz Coppinger on the Holyport Village Fair

Cllr Graham introduced Maz Coppinger who gave a short speech on the fair, which would have a pink theme, and the charities it would be supporting this year. Local residents were encouraged both to attend but also to provide help setting up and putting away.

Presentation by Louise Shenston on the Fifield Fun Day

Cllr Graham introduced Louise Shenston who gave a short speech about the background of the fun day and the charities it will support this year. Local residents were invited to attend and a request for help was made.

Annual Report

Cllr Graham gave the annual report which covered the works the Parish Council is involved in, which include; looking after the trees on Holyport Green, Supporting Manor Grove in Fifield to be a Natural Wildlife Area in association with Wild Maidenhead, improvements to the traffic flow on A308 particularly the right hand turn into Upper Bray Road, reconditioning of benches on Holyport Green, adoption of the Bray Parish Neighbourhood Plan, responding to consultations on the Borough Local Plan and Heathrow 3rd runway and M3 Smart motorway meetings.
