Bray Parish Council Cemetery Terms and Conditions

The above fees apply when the grave space is 'next in line'. If a grave space is specially selected the fees will be doubled.

For safety reasons, any bases should be placed in the ground slab and be made of metal, not glass.

No protective guard, kerb or edging may be placed around graves in the cremation area.

Memorial materials must be natural stone, granite or marble. No permanent wooden memorials will be allowed (longer than one year) photographs inscribed on headstones are subject to the Clerk's approval.

All memorials must be installed so as not to present a safety hazard for a period of at least 30 years. The base slab of lawn memorials must be made stable by an anchoring tube driven through the centre of the slab. The lawn memorial must be fixed to the base slab with a lock down system.

All memorials are the sole responsibility of the owner of the grave and should that person move from the address given in the Parish Council's Register of Purchased Graves, they must notify the Parish Clerk of their change of address. The Parish Council reserves the right to lay flat any memorial that becomes dislodged and dangerous and will endeavour to contact the owner, should this become necessary.

All permanent memorials must be approved by the Parish Council, paid for before installation and, in the case of full size graves, should not be installed for a minimum of 6 months following the burial. This is in order to prevent movement of the memorial due to ground settlement.

Any garden planted in front of a grave should only contain annual plants and is the sole responsibility of the owner of the grave. Any such garden that becomes overgrown and neglected will, at the discretion of the Parish Council be filled with top soil and grassed over. **The Parish Council reserves the right to fill in with earth and make safe, any grave that collapses and becomes a hazard to visitors in the Cemetery.**

No funerals or burials of cremated remains may take place without the prior agreement of the Parish Council. No funerals or burials of cremated remains may take place on Saturdays or Sundays.
