RBWM has ignored local opinion and continues to promote our green fields on the edge of Windsor (sites AL21 and AL22) for development – with more than 450 dwellings proposed, compounded by recent plans for an Aldi supermarket on the site as well. OGFRA will continue to fight this development when examination of the Borough Local Plan resumes in the next few months.
