005/2016. Devolution of Planning

The item on Devolution of Planning was brought forward to accommodate the presenter, Jennifer Jackson, Principle Planning Advisor from RBWM.

Cllr Kneen explained the background for the proposed devolution for the benefit of Councillors who had not been part of the original consultation.

Ms Jackson further explained that the Bray Parish planning committee would be a sub-committee of RBWM with members co-opted onto the new committee and that RBWM standing orders would be used. Councillors would be expected to complete RBWM training in order to be co-opted to the sub-committee. The types of application that would be devolved would include smaller scale applications – household applications, not change of use and no controversial applications. Cllr Burbage suggested that ward councillors would make the recommendation for contentious issues to be called in and that it was the intention that all councillors would be co-opted.

Further discussion followed with a number of items to be actioned by Ms Jackson before the Main Council Meeting on 29th February.

Ms Jackson was thanked for her presentation and she left the meeting.
