Cllr Glover raised the state of the overgrown ditch at Manor Grove. RBWM should be clearing the ditch below Manor Grove and she will chase them.

Cllr Airey raised the concerns of local residence about the cutting down of the trees at Willow Riverside Park. Cllr Kneen explained this had been dealt with on the enforcement list and no further action is to be taken.

Cllr Kiely showed the wreath she will be laying at the Thiepval Memorial on behalf of BPC in honour of the men on Bray Parish War Memorial who died in the Battle of the Soome in 1916. Cllr Dudley asked if there was anything planned locally. Cllr Kiely will find out if the British Legion has anything planned.

Cllr Elvin asked if Cllr Wilson will raise with RBWM the email sent by the EA in relation to planning application 16/00984 as he felt the wording was not acceptable

Cllr Kneen reported that the feedback from local residents concerning the extension to the conservation area had been good.

Cllr Kneen spoke about the training available for parish councillors by BALC and encouraged all councillors to attend. Also that the Clerk and Assistant Clerk will be meeting with Jenifer Jackson from RBWM Planning Department to look at the planning process.

Cllr Kneen advised that a cut off date will be included on the agenda notice for members of the public who wish to speak on a planning application. The cut off date will be close of business on the Thursday prior to meetings on Mondays.

Cllr Janikoun asked if there was date set for the planning process training. Cllr Kneen advised this was in hand and a date will be sent to councillors shortly.

Cllr Kneen asked if Cllr Wilson will speak to RBWM Planning Department to see if they can improve the quality of the plans on their website. Cllr Wilson confirmed that RBWM understand there are issues with the plans and are currently looking at what they can do to improve them.
